

# B'ounce



A completely new medium is compressed cocosubstrate, GCB. They are available in a little block of 18.5x18.5x6cm high. B'cuzz Compressed Coco is unlike other compressed coco products on the market, because it is washed and buffered which results in very easy growing. The innovation removes the necessity for buffering which means one less step. De black plastic bag is equipped with drainage holes which see to an optimum drain. The compressed coco will steep up to 20 cm.

#### **Directions for use:**

**Open the plastic bag and put this in a bucket. Add a minimum of 7 litres water with an EC value of 1.5 (temperature 20 C°). As the steeping of the coco add more water. The first drainage water after the steeping needs to be drained away. Before you plant, toss the coco (also underneath). The B'ounce blocks need to be placed with a minimum of 5 cm. from each other in order to get a good air circulation. You need to start immediately adding fertilizer. Keep the EC value in the first week at 1.2.**

The B'ounce is perfect as a stand-alone but will also fit in the Wilma Growsystems.

#### **NEW!!**

To be total organic; use the Cotex startblock 10x10x4. The Cotex is a startblock consisting of compressed coco and a thin layer of organic latex. The bottom of the Cotex is perforated to get an optimum drainage. Put the Cotex in a bucket and let it steep in hand warm water. The coco inside will raise up to 10 cm.

The hole of the startblock is flexible so you can use a small or a big cloneplug.
